<p>Hair/Personal Appearance: Must be neat, clean, and well groomed.</p> <p>Uniform Pants, Jeans and Shorts: Any business casual shade of tan, blue, gray, or black. If in doubt, ask before wearing. Pants may be uniform pants or jeans; no athletic pants or sweatpants. No leggings. Must be in good condition, fit properly. Slacks and shorts should not be frayed or have holes. No cargo style pants or shorts are allowed. Shorts may be worn year-round and can be no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the knee. No sagging pants.</p> <p>Shirts: Must be 2-4 button polo with school logo Shirts can be tucked in or worn out if the shirt is <i>HIP</i> length (3-4 inches below waist line). Solid undershirt with no writing or designs may be worn under polo. CCA crew neck sweatshirt or CCA hoodie may be worn any day. If the student anticipates taking off their sweatshirt or hoodie during the day, they must have polo on under the shirt. Friday will be CCA approved t-shirt. T-shirt must come to hip joint.</p> <p>Footwear: Grades K4 - 5th - Closed toe shoes (only), no sandals. Any color/style is permitted. Grades 6th-12th - Color and type are at the student's discretion.</p> <p>Outerwear (Polos must be worn under all jackets and sweaters): Sweaters/Cardigans: Any solid color or heathered. No stripes or patterns. Must have CCA logo. Sweatshirts: Pull over crew neck and half zipper, any color, embroidered with the CCA logo. CCA hoodies only. Fleece Jacket: Any solid color with school logo. No hood. Grades K4-5th : Outside overcoats are your choice, but they may not be worn inside during school hours. Grades 6 – 12th: No overcoats/outer wear other than those listed above.</p> <p>Miscellaneous: Piercings are allowed in ears and a single stud or hoop earring is allowed in one nostril. No septum piercings. No hats, bandana, or other headgear is to be worn during school hours.</p>	<p>Hair/Personal Appearance: Must be neat, clean and well groomed.</p> <p>Uniform pants, Jeans, Skorts, Shorts and Capris: Any business casual shade of tan, blue, gray, or black. If in doubt, ask before wearing. Pants may be uniform pants or jeans; no athletic pants or sweatpants. No leggings. Skorts (elementary only) must be no shorter than fingertip length. Shorts may be worn year-round and can be no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the knee. Slacks, skorts and Capri pants should not have any frays or holes. No cargo style pants or shorts are allowed. No jeggings or leggings. K4-5th can wear skirts, no shorter than fingertip length.</p> <p>Jumpers (K4- 5th): Solid tan, blue, gray, or black Can be no shorter than 2 inches above the top of the knee. Polo dresses in Navy or CCA shirt colors.</p> <p>Shirts: Must be 2-4 button polo with school logo Shirts can be tucked in or worn out if the shirt is <i>HIP</i> length (3-4 inches below waist line). Solid shirt or cami with no writing or designs may be worn under polo. CCA crew neck sweatshirt or CCA hoodie may be worn any day. If the student anticipates taking off their sweatshirt or hoodie during the day, they must have polo on under the shirt Friday will be CCA approved t-shirt. T-shirt must come to hip joint.</p> <p>Footwear: Grades K4 - 5th - Closed toe shoes (only), no sandals. Any color/style is permitted. Dress Down Days

Periodically throughout the year, students are allowed the privilege of dressing outside the dress code; these days are used as fundraisers for various classes, mission trips, or rewards.

Pants/Jeans/Shorts

- Must be clean, neat and gender appropriate.
- No sagging pants, no holes, patches, torn areas, or frayed edges. **NO LEGGINGS, jeggings, or Yoga pants.**
- Pants may not drag on the ground.
- Shorts: Grades K4-5th – no shorter than fingertip length.
Grades 6th -12th – may wear walking shorts to the knee.

Shirts/Tops

- No sleeveless cut-out tee shirts
- No spaghetti strap tank tops
- No halter tops
- No bare mid-riffs
- Necklines cannot go below armpit-to armpit line
- Girls' tops should not be too tight
- T-shirts must come down to hip joint
- No short shirts or tied shirts that can expose mid-drift.

Miscellaneous:

- Any clothing with messages contrary to the principles of CCA are not allowed.
- No sunglasses may be worn in the building during school hours.

Warm Weather Outdoor Events

For special outdoor events, girls may wear athletic shorts, but they must wear bike shorts underneath that come down to 3 inches above the knee. Boys may wear athletic shorts that are no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.

On the occasion that any school-sponsored event or trip includes the option of swimming, both male and female swimwear shall be modest. Females shall wear a one-piece suit or a modest tankini with no midriff showing.
